A New England icon for decades, 'Gansett underwent an identity crisis in 1982 when production was moved to Indiana. Hundreds were laid off, and perhaps worse - the beer never tasted the same. Loyal consumers claimed that the Scituate Reservoir water lent superior taste and quality to the lager. Sales declined for years.

In June 2005, Narragansett was purchased, returned home, and began the journey to reestablish its local identity. As their CEO tells it:

"We were sitting around, drinking beers, and we thought, What is quintessential about New England? We kept coming back to summertime clam bakes and clam chowder. So we said, 'f\*\*\* it, we'll declare ourselves the Official Beer of the Clam.'"
